Benefits Include:

- ♥ Arrange TSA permits and declarations, and other forms and paperwork

Payments to qualified service providers are guaranteed to a maximum of \$2,500.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What needs to happen to qualify for the plan benefits?

A: After making a low, one-time premium payment with your cremation plan purchase, Plan members are eligible for benefits if they pass away while away from their legal home address within the Continental United States. Additionally, the Plan member's next-of-kin must call the Cremation Society first, rather than calling other funeral homes or cremation providers.

Q: Who administers the Plan and who manages the services when needed?

A: The Cremation Society Travel Group, established in 1993 offers the Plan and administers your enrollment. Cremation arrangements are made by the Cremation Society through its National Emergency Assistance nationwide network of experienced, licensed crematories.

Q: Is there an annual renewal fee?

A: Travel Protection is available for purchase at the time you prepay your cremation plan. This one time, lump sum fee doesn't expire. The guarantee is there for your protection throughout the life of our pre-paid cremation plan.
