\$1,135

\$1,830

Our charge for cremation with a memorial service includes transportation from place of death within a 35-mile radius of our facility, administrative and staff services, refrigeration, cremation container, cremation and filing of death certificate. Memorial service in your church or cemetery chapel.

Traditional Ceremony Followed by Cremation

\$3,850

Complete funeral, visitation period, use of solid oak rental casket, urn, flag case, 100 memorial folders, guest register book, 25 thank you cards.
